Ric-Rac Ribs

sizes: something for everyone!

materials & gauge:

yarn:

adult - MC: 120 yards/CC: 7 yards child - MC: 100 yards/CC: 6 yards toddler - MC: 70 yards/CC: 5 yards baby - MC: 60 yards/CC: 5 yards newborn - MC: 50 yards/CC: 5 yards gauge (unstretched, in ribbed pattern):

dk/sport:4" = 24 st/31 rows worsted: 4" = 28 st/26 rows

all yarn requirements are approximate

abbreviations:

p: purl k: knit

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

as one



sl 1: slip one stitch knitwise

rnd(s): round(s)

with yarn in front

st(s): stitch(es)

	yarn weight	needle size	hat circumference relaxed/stretched	# cast on sts	length to decreases
adult	worsted	US 7/4.5 mm	14"/22"+	100	6"
child	worsted	US 7/4.5 mm	12 1/2"/ 20"	90	5"
toddler	dk/sport	US 5/3.75 mm	10"/18"	85	4 1/2"
baby (6-12 mo)	dk/sport	US 5/3.75 mm	9 1/2"/17"	80	3 1/2"
newborn	dk/sport	US 5/3.75 mm	8 1/2"/ 15"	75	2 1/2"

instructions:

- y Join into a circle, being careful not to twist.
- 10 rnds: k3, p2 around
- with CC: *sl 3 loosely knitwise with yarn in front, p2. repeat from * around.
- 2 rnds: with MC, k3, p2 around
- ★ *k1, slip tip of needle through the CC float 2 rows below and knit the next stitch, k1, p2. repeat from * around

repeat last 3 steps twice. clip CC.

before decreases (based on chart or desired length minus 2" for dk and 21/2" for worsted)

decreases:

1: k3, p2tog around

2-4: k3, p1 around

5: k2, p2tog around

6-8: k2, p1 around

9: k1, p2tog around

10-12: k1, p1 around

13: k2tog around

14: k around

15:k2tog around

finishing:

- break MC, leaving a 12" tail.
- weave through remaining loops.
- ∀ tie off and weave in ends.
